within Your house for ever.

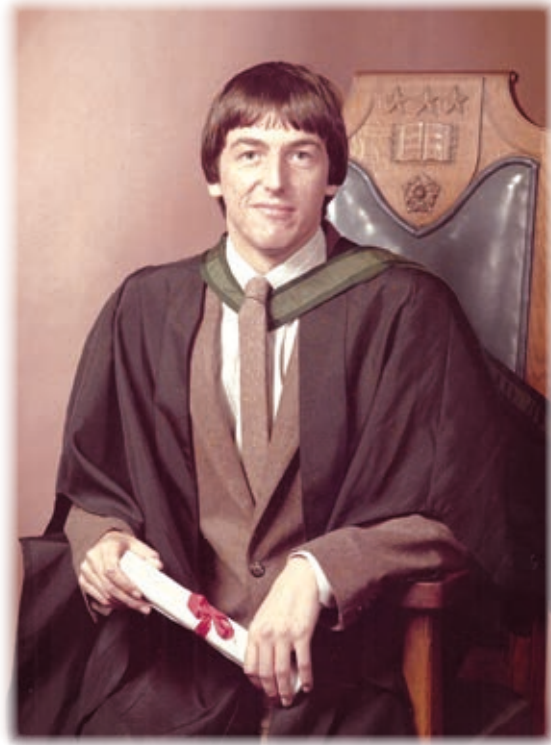
